

# CALIFORNIA DREAMIN' HANDICAPPING CONTEST

## Rules and Conditions

One lucky handicapper will win a trip for two to see the Santa Anita Derby on Saturday, April 4, 2009. The trip includes airfare, hotel (Friday and Saturday at the Santa Anita Inn), reserved seating at the track and \$500 Cdn *Mad Money*.

Here are the key points of the contest:

- Preliminaries start Saturday, January 3, 2009 and continue each Saturday including Saturday, February 28, 2009
- One winner will be declared for each Saturday up to and including February 28, 2009
- The weekly winners will face off in the California Dreamin' Handicapping Championship on March 14<sup>th</sup> in the Homestretch
- Entrants must play any three of the six designated races on the Saturday card from Santa Anita
- Players who make selections in more than three races will be automatically disqualified
- The designated races will be Races 3 thru 8 on the Saturday Santa Anita card
- Entry ballots will be available each Friday morning at 10 am for the following day's contest
- Official entries must be submitted to the HPI Info Window at the Guest Services Desk at Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino prior to the scheduled post time of the 2nd Santa Anita race on a Saturday card during the course of the California Dreamin' Handicapping Contest
- Only fully completed official entry ballots will be accepted
- One entry per person
- Multiple entries result in immediate disqualification
- By entering the California Dreamin' Handicapping Contest you agree to the use of your name and photo in any and all promotional activities conducted by Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino in association with the contest
- By entering the California Dreamin' Handicapping Contest you agree to receive promotional material from Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino (NOTE: Under no circumstances will Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino reveal or sell your contact information to third parties)
- If a participant's selected horse is scratched, the horse will be replaced with the betting favorite. If there is no place or show wagering, for the purpose of the contest, payoffs will automatically be the minimum \$2.10
- Dollars will be awarded on the official outcome of the designated races
- Dollar calculation will be based on mythical \$20 Win-Place-Show bets on each entrant's selections in the designated races
- Points example: If a winning horse pays \$7.80, \$3.40, \$2.20 then an entrant would be awarded \$134.00 for that race. If a person's horse finishes second and pays \$21.40, \$8.80, they would receive \$302.00
- Payouts will be 'capped' as follows: Win ~ 20-1 or \$42.00 to win Place ~ 10-1 or \$22.00 to place Show ~ 5-1 or \$12.00 to show
- The highest dollar total each day determines the winning entrant
- Tie-breaking criteria are as follows: (a) Entrant with most winners. (b) Entrant with most win and place horses. (c) Entrant with most win, place and show horses. (d) Ties after using the aforementioned criteria will be broken by splitting the \$100 prize money and both contestants will receive an invitation to the finals
- The weekly winner receives \$100 and an invitation to the March 14<sup>th</sup> California Dreamin' Handicapping Championship in the Homestretch
- Once a person is declared as a finalist that person is ineligible to win the weekly grand prize again, but the person may enter subsequent weeks of the contest and be eligible for a subsidiary prize
- Names of weekly winners will be posted on the homepage at [www.fraserdowns.com](http://www.fraserdowns.com), included in the official Fraser Downs program and made available to interested parties at the HPI Info Window at the Guest Services Desk at Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino in the Atrium
- Entrants must 19 years of age or over and provide valid photo ID if needed
- All prizes must be accepted as offered
- If a designated California Dreamin' race is declared as not official for any reason whatsoever the contest for that day will be shortened to five races
- There must be a minimum of four California Dreamin' races declared official for any one of the Saturday Santa Anita cards to be declared as an official contest day
- If for any reason whatsoever the minimum of four races is not achieved all entries for that day will be declared as null and void and the duration of the California Dreamin' Handicapping Contest will be shortened by one day
- If for any reason whatsoever a weekly winner cannot attend the final on March 14<sup>th</sup> the player's spot will **NOT** be filled by a substitution
- Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino cannot be responsible for entries that are lost, misplaced, destroyed, delayed or otherwise eliminated from the contest for any reason whatsoever
- Employees and agents of Fraser Downs Racetrack & Casino and all persons with whom they are domiciled are not eligible for the contest
- All decisions of the judges are final
